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Tsawwassen First Nations Treaty Day, April 3rd

On Sunday, April 3,
Tsawwassen First Nation (TFN)
celebrate Treaty Day. This is
the 13th anniversary of the
TFN Treaty, the first urban
treaty in British Columbia. This
treaty restored land ownership
and self-government
jurisdiction to the Tsawwassen
people after many years of
negotiation. You can read

Timeline of History both Pre &
Post-Treaty.

We also encourage you to read the newly released Declaration on the rights of Indigenous Peoples Act.

Within the 89 actions listed in this plan, there are a number specific to the district's continued work.

Throughout Delta, classes will be participating in the weekly Land Acknowledgement, including our school. This weekly event is led by the amazing Cultural Educator, Nathan Wilson.

Green Team

We'll be making birdhouses for the displaced Northern Flickers. We're working with Delta Parks & Rec to find the right places to mount the houses in Annieville Park.
